Evaluate the validity of this assertion. [30]

3. Life, Death and Life after Death

You must explain, exemplify and comment on **three** differing religious beliefs about the nature of life after death and be able to evaluate whether religious beliefs about life after death have any relevance in the contemporary world.

(a) Examine in detail **three** different religious beliefs about the nature of life after death.
