Talk with Law students about what it is really like to study Law at university and discover how professionals choose which career route to take after their studies

The day will comprise three parts, starting with human rights; explaining what they are, how they are protected and what this means to you. Whilst discussing rights generally, the day will also focus on some key rights which are present around the world.

The second part is focussed on civil and political rights, in particular the role of the police and their rights to search. This will involve a variety of activities and discussions around the topic.

The third part of the day will be around employment rights and how they protect the individual. This will allow the students to gain an understanding of their current rights or rights they will have when they start working.

Finally, the day will conclude with a session on student life at the University.
